BARD-THEMED U.K. ENTRY 'UNSCRIPTED' LEADS 168 SPEED FILMMAKING PACK
WITH 14 NOMS, INCLUDING BEST FILM & BEST SCRIPTURAL INTEGRATION

*Marital Dramas 'Up In The Air,' 'Still Born' and Son Sagas 'Stealing Home' & 'Saving Levi'
Vie with Frontrunner for Film, Director, Screenplay, Cinematography and Editor Nods Apr. 3-4*

LOS ANGELES (Mar. 25, 2009) -- Nominations are in for the 2009 "Family Business" edition of the 168 Film Festival (www.168project.com) (Apr. 3-4), and reflect a diversity of origin among the most recognized films which include an international entry on a theatre troupe in England, the mountainous work of a multi-168-award-winning Los Angeles team on location in Utah, a Texas-spun dialog on deliverance, a Long Beach-prepared entrée on a restaurateur's simmering clan, and an overseas rescue story whose creators, as was accomplished on "Memoirs of a Geisha" in Ventura, transformed California's central coast into a microcosm of the Far East.

Maintaining the stride foreign films have taken in the competition for Best Film in the faith-based 168 Film Project begun in 2006 when Italian nominee "Cinque Minuti" (Five Minutes) took top honors, the Shakespearean-inspired and shot-in-England runner "Unscripted," about a celebrated stage actor who while rehearsing for *King Lear* discovers he has yet to master his real-life role as a father, did not go unnoticed by jury members who bestowed a leading -- and festival-record -- 14 nominations on the film.

And like last year's finalists "Coppelius" (Germany) and "Home" (U.K.) in the timed filmmaking competition wherein entrants have seven days, or 168 hours, to shoot a short film based on random Bible verses, the York-set play-within-a-film produced by Jonathan Brown and "Home" makers Jackie Sheppard and Luke Walton finds itself a contender not just for Best International Film but Best Film itself.

Fronting a field of 22 awards-eligible films out of 58 qualifying submissions (and 67 completed films in total) that will unspool at the 7th annual 168 to be held in Glendale, Calif., at the United Community Church (Fri. Apr. 3) and Alex Theatre (Sat. Apr. 4), the British performer is up against six others for Best Film and competing with four in that same group boasting over 10 nominations each for Best Director (Paul Burbridge); Actor (Roger Alborough); Screenplay, Scriptural Integration (double nominee Nigel Forde), Cinematography (Phil Wood) and Editing (Jimi Lund).

"We congratulate all our nominees and welcome the world to two full days of over 60 inspiring short films that are going to win people's attention and hearts, not just awards," said 168 founder and executive director John David Ware. "We've got films from Canada to China, and South Central L.A. to West Texas. There's truly something for everyone."

Ninety-eight nominations (see attachments) -- determined across 17 categories by a panel of seven judges, including producer Ralph Winter ("X-Men Origins: Wolverine"), executive producer Mark Clayman ("The Pursuit of Happiness") and writer-producer Brian Bird ("Touched By An Angel") -- were divided among 18 films and 92 individuals.

Second-most considered film, two-time 168 Best Film-winning writer-director Wes Llewellyn's shot-in-Utah's-Wasatch-Mountains "Up In The Air," about the sudden reappearance of an aviator's wayward wife, landed 12 nominations, including Film (producers Chris Roberts, Doug Folsom, 2009 quadruple nominee Llewellyn); Director, Screenplay-Drama and Scriptural Integration (Llewellyn); Cinematography (Brandon Lippard); and Editing (Chris Witt).

Dallas writer-director-producer Andrew Librizzi's spousal sparrer "Still Born" and writer-director Benjamin Daniel Lobato's family diner-set, prodigal son story "Stealing Home" follow with 11 noms each, including Librizzi's edition-leading five for Film, Scriptural Integration, Director, Screenplay and Editor and Lobato's four for Scriptural Integration, Director, Screenplay and Production Design.

Rounding out the list of films with nominations in the double-digits is the China-set-but-Solvang, Calif.-hosted abandoned baby boy bio "Saving Levi" with 10, including Film (David Bradshaw, Michael Ramsey); Director, Screenplay-Drama (J. Randy Argue); Cinematography, Editor (Ralph Lindhardt); and Sound Design, Original Score (Bryan E. Miller).

Two other filmmakers earned four marks each -- actor-writer-producer Mark Blitch (grieving siblings comedy "Putting The Ash Behind You" for Comedy, Actor, Screenplay-Comedy and Editor) and five-time 168'er Theo Love (first-ever 168 musical "Love Is Good" for Film, Comedy, Director and Screenplay-Comedy). And a trio of participants had three nominations heaped on them: "Stealing Home" producer Nathan Bettisworth (Film, Editor, Production Design), "Still Born" DP/co-editor James Burgess (Cinematography, Editor, Sound Design) and missionary tale "Himig" writer Daniel Pape (Scriptural Integration, Screenplay, Production Design).

Films in this year's Best Director category ("Unscripted," "Up In The Air," "Still Born," "Stealing Home," "Saving Levi" and "Love Is Good") match up exactly with Best Film nominees and are a near-match for Best Scriptural Integration, save for "Saving Levi" which yields to "Himig."

Most-nominated in the four acting categories are "Stealing Home" and "Unscripted" with four each, "Up In The Air" with three and "Still Born," "Saving Levi," Victoria Jackson starrer "The Last Laugh," inheritance dramedy "Great Oaks," and "Putting The Ash Behind You" with two each.

Acting noms for "Stealing Home" reflect one for each category, arming Mette Holt (Actress), Frank Ashmore (Actor), Jonathan Von Schuckmann (Supporting Actor) and Francine Locke (Supporting Actress), while "Unscripted" brings out Roger Alborough (Actor), Fred Denno (Supporting Actor) and doubles up with Leah Burrows (Supporting Actress) and Rachel Wilcock (Supporting Actress).

"Up In The Air" floats Melissa Disney (Actress), Lonnie Colon (Supporting Actor) and Shannon Cunningham (Supporting Actress), while "Still Born" shows Liz Cardenas (Actress) and Todd Terry (Actor), "Saving Levi" raises Yan Cui (Actress) and Jack Ong (Actor), "The Last Laugh" headlines Jackson (Actress) and Laura Ortiz (Supporting Actress), "Great Oaks" checks in with Lauren Ashley Selfridge (Actress) and Sam Ayers (Actor) and "Putting The Ash Behind You" wills Mark Blitch (Actor) and Adam Kitchen (Actor).

Single-actor nominations were scored -- all for Supporting roles -- by "Love Is Good" (Ova Saopeng), London reminiscer "The Last Obey" (Guy Siner), toddler comedy "Joseph's Wheel of Destiny" (Kyle Lawrence), "Himig" (Emily Bolinas) and the futuristic and cautionary "The Call" (Theresa Ravnika Wu).

Nineteen individuals recorded two nominations apiece, including two sets of four teammates on “Unscripted” (Jonathan Brown, Jackie Sheppard and Luke Walton for both Film and International Film; and Nigel Forde for Scriptural Integration and Screenplay-Drama) and “Help Wanted” (Kelly Allard, Ryan Skeete, David Skidmore and Jacob Snowden for both Comedy and Screenplay-Comedy).

In addition to “Unscripted,” “Still Born,” “Stealing Home,” “Saving Levi” and “Help Wanted,” three other films can claim multiple members with multiple nominations: “Himig” with three and “Putting The Ash Behind You” and “The Last Laugh” with two.

Sixty-five people received single nominations.

Presentation of awards will take place Sat. Apr. 4 at 9:30 p.m. at the Alex Theatre at the conclusion of the two-day Apr. 3-4 program of screenings.

Guest presenters include producers Howard Kazanjian (“Star Wars,” “Raiders of the Lost Ark”), Ralph Winter (“X-Men Origins: Wolverine”) and actor-producer Brian Bird (“Touched by an Angel,” “Evening Shade”), actors Zachary Levi (“Chuck,” “Big Momma’s House 2”) and 2007 168 Best Actor Sy Richardson (2007 168 Best Film “A Good Day,” “Pushing Daisies”), and VP Twentieth Century Fox Television Gary Hall.

Rick Fry, pastor of Media City Church in Burbank, will award Best Scriptural Integration to the writer(s) of the film that, according to judges, best illustrates its randomly assigned Bible verse.
